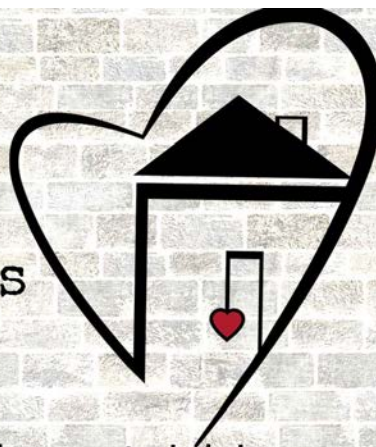

Senior Home Repair

MISSION MOMENT

The Senior Home Repair Program helps local seniors with various home repairs and accessibility limitations. These repairs range from a leaky faucet, to brand new roofs. Recently, one of the most needed home repairs was a leaky toilet.

A local senior has been dealing with a toilet leaking when it would flush. The floor had become weak from the water pooling around the base of the toilet causing it to rock back and forth. The bathroom also presented a dreadful odor. Home Is The Foundation sent a local contractor to the rescue; Bob Wolfe, from Custom Fit Plumbing. Upon his arrival, he found the floor beneath the toilet was rotted with mold and mildew and the toilet flange was broken and not connected. Bob repaired the sub-floor and flooring beneath the toilet and installed a new flange to set a new ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) approved toilet.

Our resident is grateful for this home repair. It has given her greater independence and increased accessibility within her own home.
